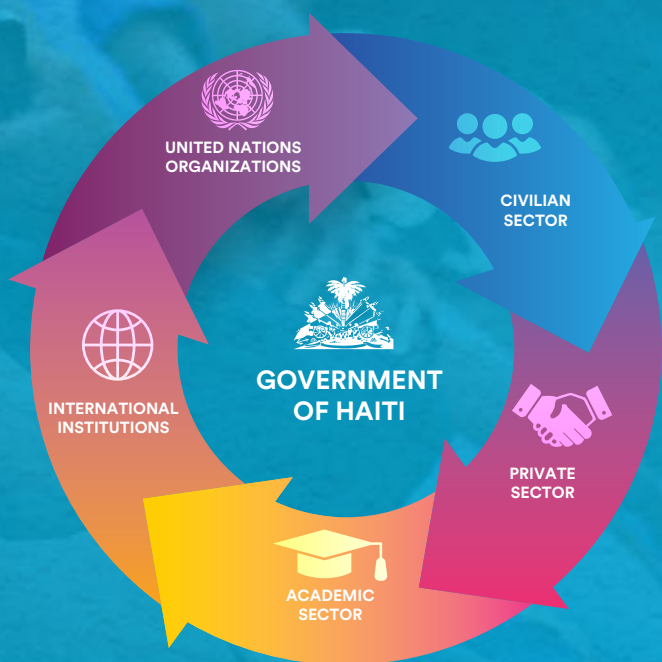

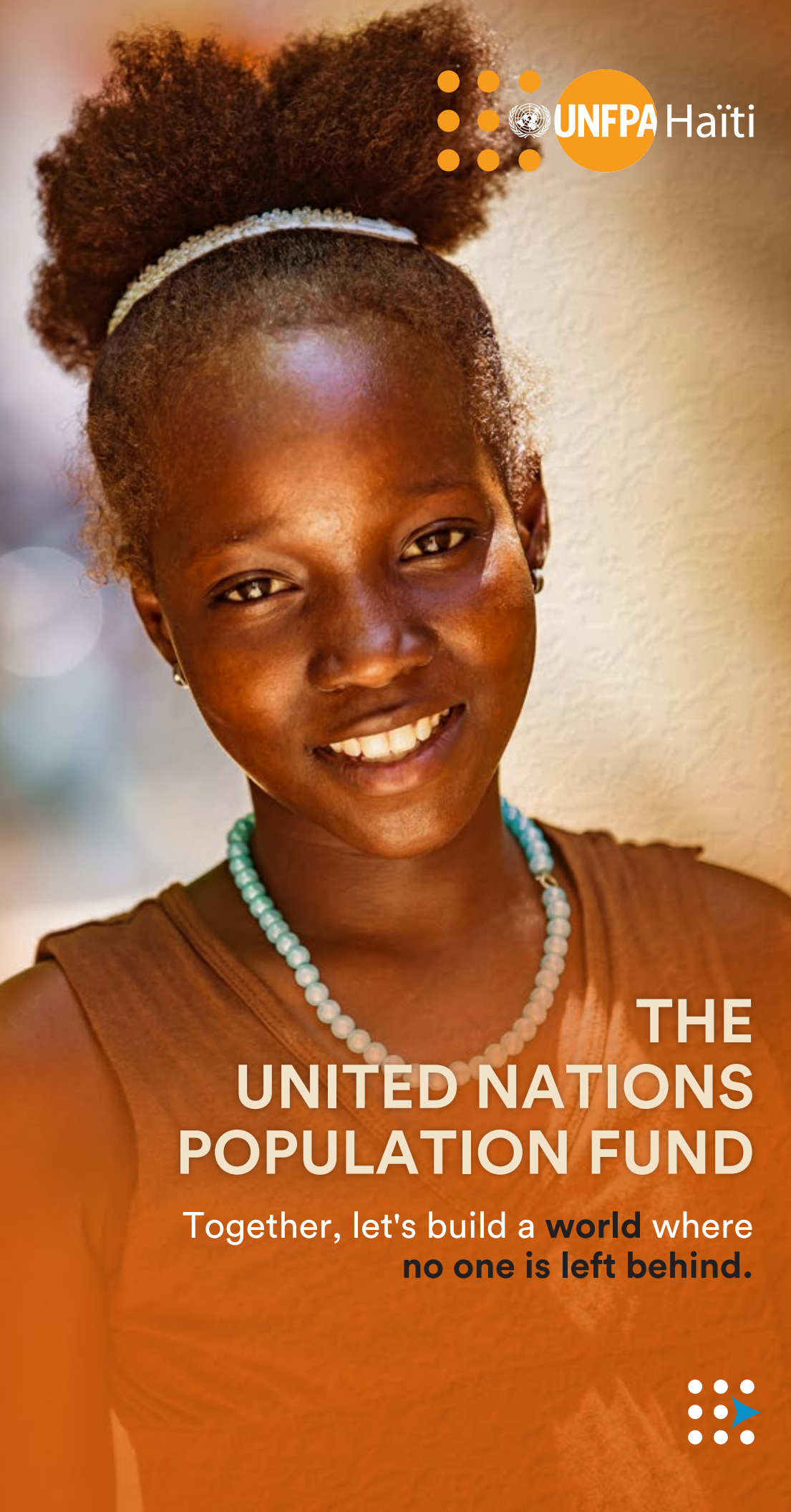

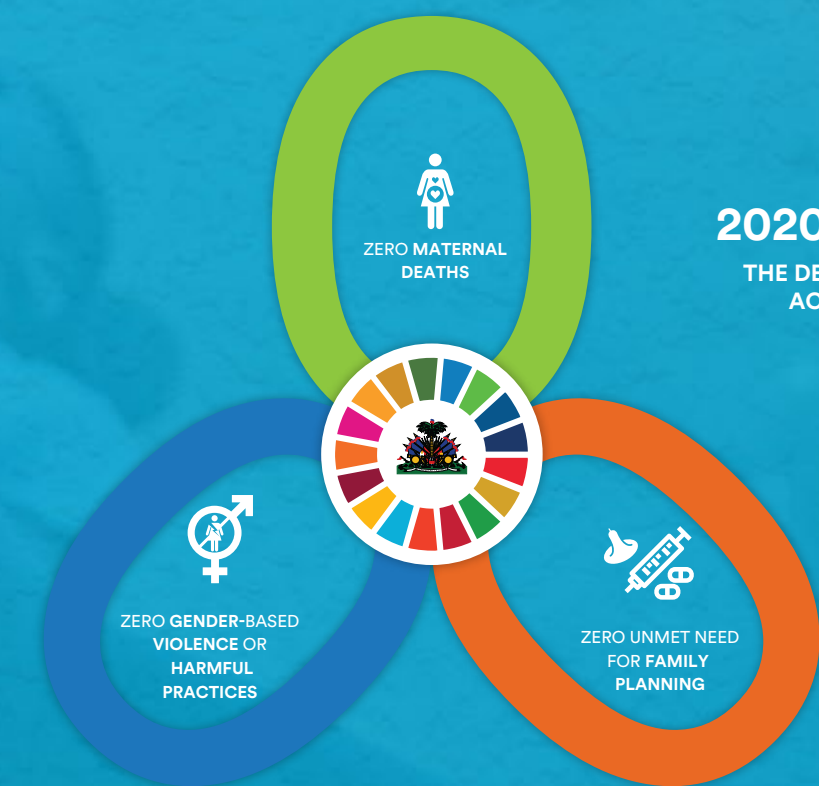
Together, let's build a world where **no one is left behind.**

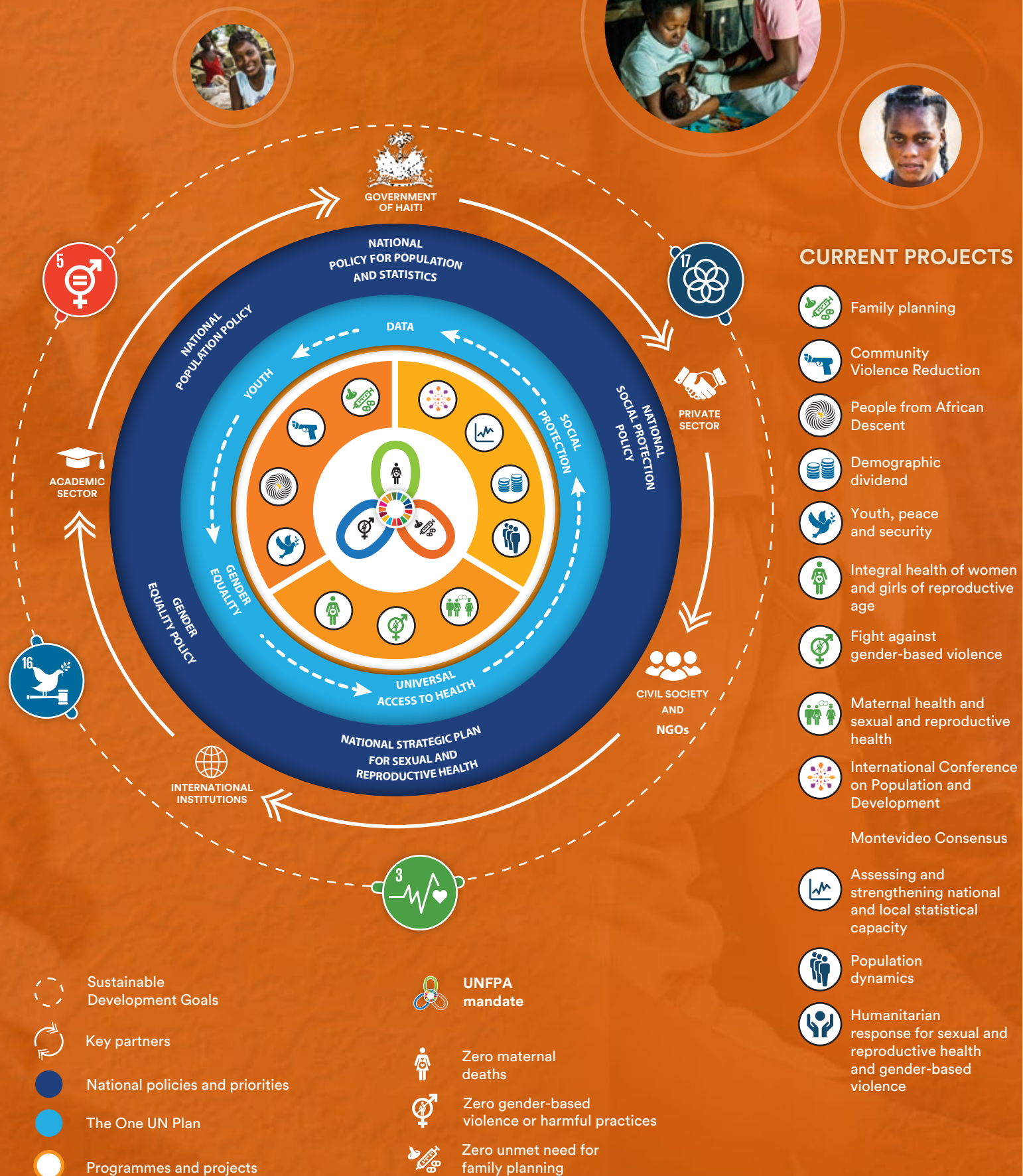
## IMPROVING SEXUAL AND REPRODUCTIVE HEALTH

- Increasing the availability of modern quality sexual and reproductive health services
- Training of midwives and nurse anesthetists
- Promoting and defense of the right to a safe motherhood, while protecting the mother's dignity
- Improving access to sexual and reproductive health services, that are culturally sensitive and, suitable for adolescents and young people
- Reducing early pregnancies

- Improving access to comprehensive sexuality education and sexual and reproductive health services

- Promoting transformational leadership and intergenerational dialogue

## OUR CONTRIBUTION TO PEACE IN HAITI

UNFPA and the United Nations Integrated Office in Haiti (BINUH) are the co-conveners of the community violence reduction (CVR) benchmark 2 of the ONE UN Plan in Haiti. We are actively supporting the development of the National Strategy for Disarmament, Dismantlement, Reintegration and Community Violence Reduction (NSDDR/CVR)

## REDUCING GENDER-BASED VIOLENCE

- Investing in women's empowerment

- Implementing programmes and integrating gender issues in public plans and policies
- Ensuring that sexual and reproductive health services always reach survivors and vulnerable people caught in -humanitarian crises

## CENSUS AND DATA FOR DEVELOPMENT

- Provide technical and financial support for the census and national surveys
- Support development of evidence-based public policies targeting vulnerable groups
- Strengthen statistical capacities at the national and local levels for the collection, analysis, production and dissemination of data
- Disseminate, and raise awareness of updated data to facilitate decision-making
- Promote and facilitate South-South cooperation on statistics, data and population issues
