

PROJECT TITLE

Strengthening access to integrated, lifesaving SRH and GBV services and supplies for women of reproductive age in earthquake affected departments (Grand'Anse, Nippes and South)

The main objective of this USAID Bureau for Humanitarian Assistance (BHA) is to strengthen UNFPA's immediate humanitarian response in Haiti in the aftermath of the earthquake. The project focused on:

- ▶ **INTERVENTION I** : Strengthening Gender-Based Violence (GBV) coordination at national and subnational level;
- ▶ **INTERVENTION II** : Strengthening integrated sexual and reproductive Health (SRH) and GBV service provision
- ▶ **INTERVENTION III** : Strengthening GBV case management

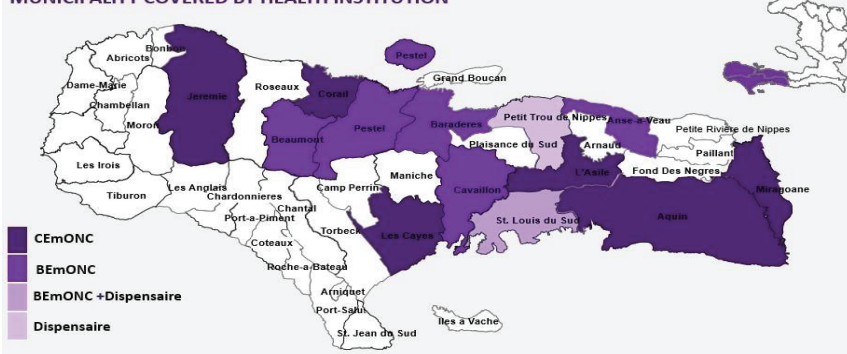

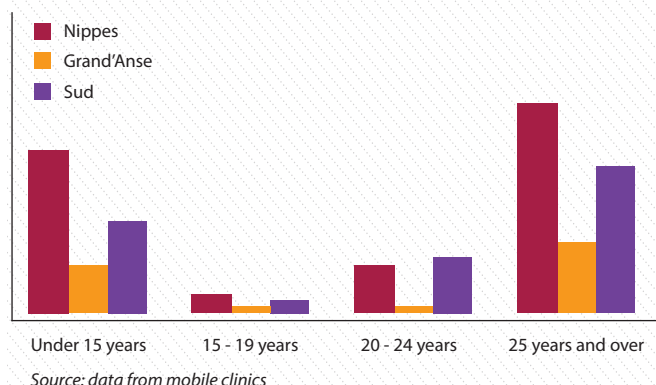

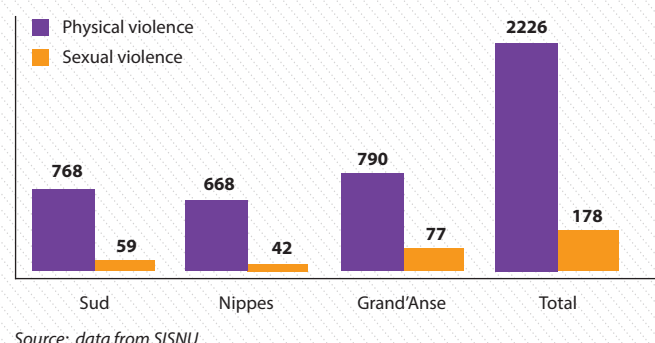
